Penguin Golf Tour Rules

U.S.G.A. rules apply except for the following local rules:

1. Winter rules:

One (1) club length relief. The ball may be marked, cleaned and placed within one club length no closer to the hole than the original lie & <u>must</u> <u>stay in same condition</u>. The one club relief <u>MAY NOT</u> be used to move the ball <u>ON TO A PUTTING GREEN</u> or <u>OUT OF A HAZARD</u>.

2. Hazards:

- A. All water hazards shall be played as **LATERAL WATER** hazards.
- B. If no markings, the water's edge defines the hazard boundary.
- C. Ball in a hazard is entitled one club length relief but must remain in the hazard and in the original condition. NOTE: One club length MAY NOT be used to move ball out of the water.
- D. Ball in bunker, sand may be smoothed, and ball may be placed within one club length of the original lie no closer to the hole <u>WITHIN</u>

 <u>THE HAZARD</u>. If bunker is unplayable, "Unplayable ball" relief may be used to move out of hazard with a <u>ONE STROKE</u> penalty.

4. All players must sign the scorecard!

Write clearly using first and last names and.

5. The Penguin Tour is a golf tournament. The ball MUST be holed. NO GIMMIES!!

Breech of rule is **Disqualification**.
